

Preparing for a Tutoring Session

ADVANCING READERS

Before each session:

- Pick up your student's box.
- Review previous tutor notes and the Roadmap.
- Pick up the lesson packet your student is working on today.
- Select a tutor read aloud. If the student did not finish the tutor read aloud in the previous session, select that title and pick up where your student left off.
- Read through the materials inside the lesson packet to familiarize yourself with the skill you will teach today.
- Create an agenda on a post-it or whiteboard. Use the following as a guide:
 1. Tutor read aloud
 2. Review vocabulary & add 1-2 new words
 3. Comprehension skill
 - a. For the "A" lesson you can write "Learn and practice ____ (insert skill)"
 - b. For the 'B' lesson you can write "Review ____ (insert skill)"
 4. Student read aloud
 5. Graphic organizer
 6. Take Reading Home

Helpful hints:

- Always check in with your site coordinator if you have any questions about notes from a previous session or the contents of the lesson packet.
 - Have all of the materials prepared before your student arrives at the reading center.
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
